Troy Gallier shows his latest tool bargain, a Sears biscuit jointer that he got off the markdown table.



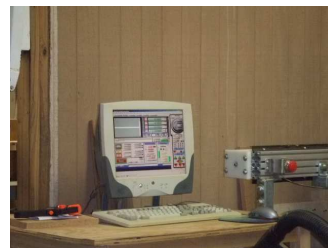

## Program

Jerry Shivers presented the program on his new, home-built CNC routing machine. Some time back a former club member, Ken Berry, did a program about his home-built CNC machine and Jerry thought it might help him enhance some of his furniture items. He investigated the various plans that are available on the internet, talked to people that had already built one and then he built this one.



John Phelps did the electrical work, as well as the computer system and interface design and installation. Jerry's son-in-law, John Bourgeois, uses computer graphics software to translate the desired design into machine code that drives the router to carve the wood. So far, they've made some signs and carved various logos into blanket chests and tables.



Jerry said that his CNC machine cost several thousand dollars to build but a commercial machine would have been 3-4 times more expensive.
